

# 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Supply List

## 2011 / 2012

**3 Boxes of Kleenex**

**4 packs of wide ruled paper** (1 to leave in math; the rest for all other classes as needed – buy enough to last the year)

**1- 1½ binder** (social studies)

**1 pack of dividers** (social studies)

**8 spirals**

**4 folders with pockets and brads** (one will be a homework folder, the rest will be used in various classes)

**Box of at least 20 count wooden #2 pencils** (to leave in math)

**Pencils (prefer mechanical)** students keep some in pencil bag to use in all classes – should buy enough to last the year

**Blue or black pens** (students keep some in pencil bag - should buy enough to last all year for all classes)

**Pencil bag**

**Grading pens** (students keep some in pencil bag – should buy enough to last all year for all classes)

**1 large pink eraser** (math)

**Pack of glue sticks** (students keep one in pencil bag; turn the rest in)

**Construction paper** (any size – students turn in)

**Large package of manila paper** (students turn in)

**Scissors** (students keep in pencil bag)

**Colors or map colors** (students keep in pencil bag)

**flash drive** (keep at home for times when larger projects are assigned)

**The students will keep most of their own materials. Please keep in mind that school supplies are cheaper at the beginning of the school year. We suggest you buy enough pens, pencils, and paper to last the school year.**
