

Addendum To Handbook 2010 – 2011

Cumby High School calculates grade point averages on a two tiered system of 4.00 on all classes and 5.00 on all honors, advanced, and dual credit college classes. Under this system the following classes will not be calculated into a students' GPA: Physical Education and Athletics, all TAKS preparation classes, teacher and library aides, office aides, correspondence classes, summer school classes, and other remedial classes.

Classes that are calculated on 5.00 are: All approved college classes, Honors English I, II, III, Honors Chemistry, Honors Biology, Honors Geometry, Honors Algebra II, Spanish III, Pre-Calculus, and Physics.

All other classes taught at Cumby High School will be calculated using 4.00.
