Teacher Appreciation Contest

Our Box Tops Program has been VERY successful this school year. So far this school year we have collected over 11,600 Box Tops!! Our success is all because you participate in our program. Our Teachers are also an important part of our program. They help us collect the Box Tops that each of you turn in and they make sure that I get the Box Tops so you get chances in our monthly drawings. They also help me to provide you with collection sheets and information about our program. So I would like to announce a contest that allows each grade the opportunity to reward your teachers.

The Teacher Appreciation Contest begins March 3rd and ends April 30th 2008. There are 2 ways to win, one reward for the teachers and one reward for the grade. Here is how the contest works:

1. Students continue to bring in your Box tops and turn them into your teacher. You may bring them in on collection sheets or in baggies. If you use baggies be sure that your name and your grade is on the bag. This helps me keep track for the contest, and allows me to enter you in the monthly drawing too. All the Box Tops for the Teacher Appreciation Contest will count in our monthly drawings just like always. On April 1st, I will post the progress of each grade in the hall with our Goal Thermometer.
2. Here is the way each teacher wins: Each grade who meets the contest goal of bringing in at least **200 Box Tops** will win a Teacher Appreciation Gift Basket to give to their teachers during Teacher Appreciation Week, May 5th – 9th. So for example, if the 1st grade students bring in 200 or more Box Tops during the contest (March 3rd – April 30th), then Mrs. Stone and Mrs. Yarbrough each get a gift basket during Teacher Appreciation Week.
3. Here is the way each grade wins: At the end of the contest, the grade that has the highest average number of Box Tops turned in per student will win Popcorn & a Movie. The teachers of the winning grade will select the date for the movie. Using the highest average number of Box Tops per student makes the contest fair no matter how many students are in each grade. This way it is fair to each grade because the smaller grades with only 20 students can compete with the larger grades with 40+ students.
4. DON'T FORGET—All the Box Tops turned in count toward the Teacher Appreciation Contest and in the Monthly Box Tops Drawing too!! One more way we all win when everyone saves Box Tops.

So here are your goals for each grade:

- Each Grade Bring in 200 Box Tops to Earn Teacher Appreciation Gift Baskets for your Teachers.
- Each Student Bring in Box Tops so you have the Highest Average number of Box Tops per student to win Popcorn & a Movie.
- Each Student who brings in Box Tops gets one chance in the monthly drawing for every 10 Box Tops.
